# Family Festival Part Two:

Don't have a family a four! Don't need to rent equipment! Don't care about the Horse-Drawn Wagon Rides! I'd be happy to try and put some ala carte pricing together and most likely get the cost under \$500 per couple.

## For Example:

2 day adult lift tickets are \$128 so for 2 \$256 – if we can get rooms for under \$167 a night we will be coming in lower than the family package – I believe we can get something closer to \$125 a night and that's where the savings come in.

If you have 2 adults and one child under the age of 18 – it's best to go with the package; ala carte you would have to pay an additional \$128 for any child 13+ or \$108 for any child 6-12 – that leaves quite a bit less to work with for a room rate. The same applies if you have start adding rental equipment.

So here's the deal – if you are two adults interested in this trip – you need to let me know **NOW** so I can start holding rooms – rooms will start to get booked and prices will go up so don't delay.
