### Ski Trip Reports


#### **ABSF Ski-a-Thon at Devils Head**

### RON'S TRAILSIDE HEALTHY CHILI

3 CAN BUSH'S CHILI BEANS DRAINED SLIGHTLY (MILD, MEDIUM OR HOT)

4 CANS RED GOLD or ROTEL OR ALDI BRAND PETITE DICED TOMATOES WITH GREEN CHILI'S. (DRAINED) MILD OR HOT. MAKE SURE PETITE.

1 CAN BLACK BEANS - ANY BRAND (RINSED)

16-20 OZ GROUND TURKEY MEAT (7% FAT) – IF YOU REALLY WANT IT HEALTHY GET THE GROUND TURKEY BREAST (1% FAT) I PREFER THE 20 OZ PACKAGE OF JENNY-O

1 Medium YELLOW ONION - DICED

1 Lg RED OR YELLOW (OR BOTH) PEPPER DICED

1 CUP FROZEN WHITE CORN (Optional)

1/4 CUP CHOPPED JALAPENA PEPPERS OR SPORT PEPPERS (To desired heat)

<u>1 – PACKET MCCORMICK CHILI SEASONING</u> (DESIRED HEAT)

3-4 OZ PACIFICO BEER (Optional)

Empty all cans into your slow cooker. If you want thick chili, drain all cans well.

Brown the turkey, drain and add to mix.

Stir in 1 package of your desired heat chili seasoning; cook at least 6-8 hours stirring occasionally. Leave lid off last hour of cooking to thicken.

I usually add some extra chili seasoning.
